The Town of Afton ("Town") received a change of land use application ("Change of Use") on May 6, 2019 from NY Afton I, LLC (the "Applicant", an affiliate of Delaware River Solar, LLC) to construct and operate an approximately 3.27 Mwac community solar facility and three (3) battery storage systems at 271 County Road 17 (the "Project"). The applicant has submitted a Project Memorandum, proposed Site Plan, Part 1 Full Environmental Assessment Form, and Decommissioning Plan and Agreement (collectively with the Change of Use application, the "Submitted Materials").

The Town of Afton Planning Board reviewed the Submitted materials on May 6, 2019 and has provided a positive recommendation to the Town Board for approval of the project.

Pursuant to General Muicipal Law – GMU*239-n, the Town of Afton Board ("Town Board") referred the Application to the Chenango County Planning Board on May 8, 2019. At the Chenango County Planning Board on June 11, 2019 the Chenango County Planning Board provided an approval of the Project with a recommendation to add vegetative screening along County Road 17.

The proposed action is an Unlisted action pursuant to SEQR 6 NYCRR Part 617.4 and the Town Board on May 8, 2019 declared pursuant to the provisions of SEQR 6 NYCRR Part 617 its intent to be lead agency with an uncoordinated review.

The Town Board has requested a PILOT agreement be entered into between the Applicant and the Town.

Now Therefore, it be resolved, that the Afton Town Board hereby:

Finds that the proposed Unlisted action will not have significant effect on the environment and the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement will not be required, and hereby issues a Negative Declaration per SEQR 6 NYCRR Oart 617.12;

Approves the Change of Une in land from agricultural use to use for hosting the Project at the referenced property:

Reserves a determination per the County's recommendation for additional screening on County Road 17 pending completion of construction of the Project and input from the Host landowners:

Approves the Decommissioning Plan and Agreement and authorizes it execution; and

Approves and authorizes the execution of a \$5000?MWac/yar PILOT, fixed for a period of up to thirty (30) years. The Town Board Authorizes the Town Assessor to negotiate any remaining PILOT share allocations with the School District and County, conditioned on the Town retaining a minimum 50% share of such PILOT payments.
