L Shultis priced a new truck from Stadium International. Truck cab and chassis \$108609.00 with the option of an automatic transmission priced at \$14000.00 additional if so wished. We do not want to pursue the automatic transmission at this time. The price received from Wayne's Welding to up fit the truck with existing box and new plow equipment is \$49350.00 and truck can be available first week of June for a total of \$108649.00.

Other options include purchasing a used truck. L Shultis to get some information on what is available. J Lawrence with contact John Winn's Garage to find out about prices for repairing the existing truck and the availability of renting a truck to use from the county while repairs are being made.

L Shultis asked to revisit the sand pile situation as it is time to begin hauling sand for next winter. Decision was made to keep sand pile in current location with the loading ramp to be moved to back to buffer the noise and lights, also a row of spruce trees will be planted along road to help further reduce noise and light to neighboring properties.

S McIntyre addressed board with information on the changes that are tentative to the Basic Star exemption. Stated that the enhanced star would not be affected.
